### FIRE STATION FUNDING

In June, Delta City, in conjunction with the Fire District, began meeting with the Utah Community Impact Bond (CIB) organization to secure funding for a new fire station. We are pleased to announce that on October 1<sup>st</sup> we were awarded a grant in the amount of \$1,810,000.00 and a 20 year 1.5% Interest loan in the amount of 777,000.00 for a total of \$2,587,000.00. The loan payments will be made by the Millard County Fire District.

We are excited to be able to provide our volunteer firemen improved working, training and housing for vehicles and equipment.

The City has purchases property just east of the City park at 100 W Main. Demolition and utility installation will begin in the next couple of weeks with construction slated for the spring.

We appreciate the interest and concerns of the residents and will take them into consideration as we proceed with the planning process.


