PUBLIC NOTICE

Delta City will hold a public hearing within the Delta City Council Chambers, 76 N 200 W, Delta, Utah, 84624, on October 4, 2012 at 6:30 PM to discuss the Water Improvement Project at the Sherwood Shores Subdivision, Utah. The findings of the Environmental Assessment will be presented. The proposed project includes the following:

1. Approximately 10,300 feet of 12-inch diameter PVC C900 pipe and fittings would be installed to convey water from Delta to the Sherwood Shores Subdivision. With the exception of an approximately 2,000-foot segment that would be installed to cross the Gunnison Bend Reservoir using the directional drilling method, the pipeline would be primarily along the right-of-way (ROW) of existing roads. The proposed pipeline would run through Sections 10 and 11, Township 17 South, Range 7 West, Salt Lake Base and Meridian (SLBM).
2. Additionally, approximately 6,800 feet of 8-inch diameter distribution lines would be installed within existing road ROW to replace the existing 2-inch diameter lines in Sections 10 and 15, Township 17 South, Range 7 West, SLBM.

All interested parties shall be given an opportunity to be heard.
