

## EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY

Delta City currently has an opening for a Maintenance Worker position in our Public Works division. The successful applicant will perform an extensive array of tasks across the various Public Works divisions including, but not limited to our airport, parks, streets, sewer and water departments and occasional capital projects and infrastructure work.

In general, the successful applicant will work to improve, maintain and repair our City streets, parks and other municipal properties, will maintain sewer lines and our culinary water distribution system including the system's telemetry controls. Some of the typical heavy equipment that the successful applicant will need to have experience with includes backhoes, track hoes, loaders, graders, dump trucks and other utility vehicles. Must also be able to operate compactors, water pumps, mowers, sewer cleaning equipment and various power and hand tools as necessary. Must have knowledge of typical materials, equipment and methods used in general maintenance, construction and repair industries. General knowledge of electrical panels and wiring, and motors would be helpful. Must also be skilled in the use of various hand and power tools, small and heavy equipment too. Must also be able to assess and demonstrate general repair and maintenance procedures. Successful applicant may perform other duties as assigned, such as being the lead person and supervising subordinate employees on maintenance projects as assigned by and also works directly under supervision of the Public Works Director or his/her Assistant. This job classification will require a certain amount of on-call (pager) duty that requires a fifteen (15) minute response time.

The successful candidate will minimally need to be a high school graduate or have the equivalent combination of education and work experience including at least six (6) months of experience in this type of work and having used the kinds of heavy equipment, vehicles, tools and equipment noted within this position description. Applicant will be required to have a valid Utah commercial driver license (CDL) or be able to acquire a CDL license within six (6) months of being hired for this position. Applicant will need to be insurable under the employer's vehicle policy, must pass a pre-hiring drug test and be subject to random testing thereafter while employed. Must be able to lift and move one-hundred (100) pounds. Must have ability to perform manual tasks involving physical strength and endurance under variable and in often adverse weather and environmental conditions for extended periods of time. *Please be advised that Delta City reserves the right to reject any and all applicants and is an equal opportunity employer.*
