Mayor Bunker called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. He stated that notice of the time, place and the agenda of the meeting had been posted at the City Building, on the Utah Public Notice website, the Delta City website, and had been provided to the Millard County Chronicle-Progress and to each member of the City Council at least two days prior to the meeting

Opening remarks were provided by Council Member John Niles, following which Mayor Bunker led those in attendance in the Pledge of Allegiance.

MINUTES

The minutes of the Public Hearing were presented for approval. Following a discussion, Council Member John Niles MOTIONED to adopt the minutes of the Public Hearing held July 17, 2014 as corrected. The motion was SECONDED by Council Member Robert Banks. The minutes of the regular meeting of City Council held July 17, 2014 were presented for approval. Following a discussion Council Member Kiley Chase MOTIONED to adopt the minutes of the Regular City Council Meeting held July 17, 2014 as presented. The motion was SECONDED by Council

Member Steven Pratt. The motion passed with Council Member Kiley Chase, Council Member Robert Banks, Council Member Steven Pratt, and Council Member John Niles voting in favor, and Council Member Betty Jo Western being absent.

ACCOUNTS PAYABLE

The Council reviewed the accounts payables of August 07, 2014 in the amount of \$175,883.18; copies of which had been provided to them at least two days prior to the meeting. Following a discussion Council Member Robert Banks MOVED to approve the accounts payables for August 07, 2014 in the amount of \$175,883.18 as presented. The motion was SECONDED by Council Member Kiley Chase. Mayor Bunker asked if there were any questions or comments regarding the motion. There being none, he called for a vote. The motion passed with Council Member Kiley Chase, Council Member Robert Banks, Council Member Steven Pratt, and Council Member John Niles voting in favor, and Council Member Betty Jo Western being absent.

Payroll & Electronic Disbursements

The Council reviewed the Payroll and the Electronic Disbursements of August 7, 2014 in the amount of \$85,546.47; copies of which had been provided to them at least two days prior to the meeting. Following a discussion Council Member Kiley Chase MOVED to approve the Payroll and the Electronic disbursements as presented. The motion was SECONDED by Council Member Steven Pratt. Mayor Bunker asked if there were any questions or comments regarding the motion. There being none, he called for a vote. The motion passed with Council Member Kiley Chase, Council Member Robert Banks, Council Member Steven Pratt, and Council Member John Niles voting in favor, and Council Member Betty Jo Western being absent.

PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD

There were no comments from the public.

Business

Municipal Shooting Range Board Proposing Shooting Range Rule Enforcement

Council Member John Niles, representing the Municipal Shooting Range Advisory Board, reported that the Shooting Range Board asked for consideration of some recourse to take for the violation of rules at the shooting range. Council Member Niles explained some of the violations that were happening and shared the Board's frustration to the Council. City Attorney Todd Anderson advised the Council on possible retributions for violators that were discussed by the Shooting Range Board. A discussion with the Council about possible solutions ensued. The possibility of enforcement by banning blatant violators from the Shooting Range for a period of time was considered by the Board as a whole, not one independent member. Council Member John Niles MOVED to pursue the County for an Ordinance that would allow the Shooting Board to authorize the banning of violators from the Shooting Range for a decided period of time, with City Council ruling if there were an appeal. Council Member Kiley Chase SECONDED the motion. Mayor Bunker asked if there were any questions or comments regarding the motion.

There being none, he called for a vote. The motion passed with Council Member Kiley Chase, Council Member Robert Banks, Council Member Steven Pratt, and Council Member John Niles voting in favor, and Council Member Betty Jo Western being absent.

Sewer Camera Upgrade

Public Works Director Alan Riding reported on the sewer camera that is presently old and insufficient. Replacement of parts for repair are obsolete and outdated. Mr. Riding proposed the purchase of a new sewer camera with higher definition. Mayor Bunker stated that the camera was a valuable asset for the Public Works. Council Member John Niles MOVED to approve the purchase of a new camera for the sewer at the cost of \$17,753.00. Council Member Robert Banks SECONDED the motion. Mayor Bunker asked if there were any questions or comments regarding the motion. There being none, he called for a vote. The motion passed with Council Member Kiley Chase, Council Member Robert Banks, Council Member Steven Pratt, and Council Member John Niles voting in favor, and Council Member Betty Jo Western being absent.

Public Works Update

Public Works Director Alan Riding gave an update of the Public Works projects. Mr. Riding reported that they had finished the water line project and it was asphalted. The Public works had been working on equipment repairs and maintenance. City Attorney Todd Anderson informed Mr. Riding that Centracom was interested in contacting someone in the Public Works.

OTHER BUSINESS

Mayor Bunker stated that there was going to be a tribute for someone who had passed with a military salute in the park the following weekend. Mayor Bunker informed that he had received a request from the Delta High School renaming 3rd North "Rabbit Avenue." It had been previously approved (20 years ago) but not followed up on. There was a discussion regarding this request. It would not change resident addresses, Mayor Bunker stated. City Recorder Greg Schafer informed the Council that the Delta High School was also asking for an exception to the noise ordinance law on August 15 from 9 p.m. until 12 a.m. for an outside dance held between the new High School and the Palladium. The Council gave their approval for this request. Mayor Bunker discussed annexation on a strip of property around the airport with the Council. Mayor Bunker passed a map to show proposed annexation. Mayor Bunker informed that he had contacted Connie Hansen with the Millard County Recorder's Office and others so that it may be done correctly. Mayor Bunker stated that his contacts did not see an unsurmountable problem. Mayor Bunker said that this was months from being done, but that he wanted to inform the Council on the proposed changes. City Recorder Greg Schafer took a census on who would be attending Utah League of Cities and Towns.

Mayor Bunker asked if there were any comment, questions, or other items to be discussed. There being none, Council Member Robert Banks MOVED to adjourn the regular City Council meeting. Council Member John Niles SECONDED the motion. The motion passed with Council

Member Kiley Chase, Council Member Robert Banks, Council Member Steven Pratt, and Council Member John Niles voting in favor, and Council Member Betty Jo Western being absent.

Mayor Bunker declared the meeting adjourned at 7:56 p.m.
