Chairman Rick Nielson called the meeting to order at 6:40 p.m. He stated that notice of the time, place and the agenda of the meeting had been posted at the City Building, on the Utah Public Notice website, the Delta City website, and had been provided to the Millard County Chronicle- Progress and to each member of the Municipal Shooting Range Advisory Board at least two days prior to the meeting.

MINUTES

There were no minutes to be presented for approval.

BUSINESS

REPORT ON RANGE SIGNAGE AND PARKING BARRIERS

Chairman Nielson reported that the Signs were complete. Chairman Nielson stated that he got eight large cement parking barriers from the Millard County Posse. Chairman Nielson suggest that they get the power poles from Pacific Corp for miscellaneous uses. Chairman Nielson said that his concern regarding the parking barriers were mainly for the protection of the new signs.

RANGE RULE ENFORCEMENT PLAN

Chairman Nielson proceeded to notify the Board of new instances of rules being abused at the range. Chairman Nielson asked City Attorney Todd Anderson if there were ordinances that could be put into place to enforce the range rules. Mr. Anderson informed the Board that any ordinance would have to be passed by Millard County and then the Sheriff's Office could

26 enforce them. There was a discussion regarding putting an ordinance through the County for
27 this purpose with the Board and City Attorney Todd Anderson. Chairman Nielson asked what
28 recourse they had for blatant rule breakers. The idea of being able to charge trespassing on
29 those abusing the range rules was discussed and City Attorney Anderson stated that it could be
30 brought before City Council for approval once the Board decided what they wanted to do.
31 Board Member Brett Nielson suggested that if the trespasser were reported to the Sheriff's
32 Office there would be a report and record so that if it happened again, it would be a criminal
33 offense. Chairman Nielson stated that he felt that if anyone saw something reportable, to
34 contact Chairman Nielson with name, address, etc. At that point he would contact City Public
35 Works to have a warning letter sent to the offender. Then additional cites would result in a
36 trespass with a determination to not return to the Shooting Range for a time limit.

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38 **OTHER BUSINESS**

39 The Board briefly discussed the plan to obtain some armor framed gongs and also short range
40 target stands. The Board also discussed getting the Delta City Crew to assist on some of the
41 range projects. The Board proposed getting the grant information done before November when
42 it is due. There was a discussion on grant projects, and a canopy was suggested as a possibility
43 for the grant. Gates were deliberated on by the Board, and it was determined that a small gate
44 was desired. They scheduled the next meeting for 6:30 on the first Wednesday of August.
