Mayor Farnsworth stated that the Hearing had been called to adopt a Tentative Budget, prepared by Robison & Hill, Certified Public Accountants, Salt Lake City, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1973.

Following a complete study and discussion of the tentative budget Councilman Leo Burraston moved its adoption. His motion was seconded by Councilman Arch Barben and carried the unanimous affirmative vote of all Councilmen present as follows:

Cox offered a resolution and moved its adoption amending the General Fund of the 1971-72 Budget to \$122,387.78 and the Expenditures to \$102,725.98 in accordance with Utah Code Annotated, 1953 Section 10-10-50 through Section 10-10-52. His motion was duly seconded by Councilman Neil Forster and carried the unanimous affirmative vote of all Councilmen present as follows:

Diane Mecham, new custodian for City Offices, be paid \$25.00 a month after deductions.

Councilman Clark B. Cox moved that Mayor Farnsworth's recommendations be adopted. His motion was seconded by Councilman Willard Stephenson and carried the unanimous affirmative vote of all Councilmen present.

Public Relations of Officer Dennis Floto were discussed. All Councilmen were of the opinion that Officer Floto should work with Officer Wood for a week.
