



afterwhich there was a very lengthy discussion of the amount of the fee and how it should be determined.

Mayor Roper explained to those in attendance that the meeting was a public hearing for the purpose of receiving citizen comments on a preapplication the city is preparing to send to the Department of Housing and Urban Development.

Roger Stowell explained to council he has been working on the proposed projects to be included in the preapplication to HUD and upon reviewing the minutes of the first public hearing held October 14th in regards to the preapplication and an on site survey he would recommend a portion of the grant should be used for rehabilitation of low and moderate income residents homes.

There was a general discussion of the needs of the area it was the opinion of those in attendance at the meeting that the projects for the proposed pre-

application to HUD should be to carry out a program of housing rehabilitation to help basically low and moderate income residents, some additional water and sewer line work as well as street, curb and sidewalk improvements in the low and moderate income areas within the Delta City limits.

There were no public objections to the recommendations for the proposed projects for HUD funding for Delta City.

Mayor Roper asked if there were any further questions or comments, there being none the Mayor thanked all those in attendance for their comments.

There being no further business Councilman Bennett MOVED the meeting be adjourned, SECONDED by Councilman Callister, meeting adjourned at 7:55 p.m.
