

Mayor Nielson stated to those present that the Public Hearing had been advertised in the Millard County Chronicle for the required time and that the purpose of the meeting was to receive public comment on the proposed change in the Future Land Use map and also to receive comment on the request of National Landmark Development Co. to change the zone on Lots 2 & 3 on Block 33 from R-2 to R-4.

The Mayor recognized Ralph Stoneking. Mr. Stoneking stated that he is opposed to the zone change because of the impact that apartments and the increase of population have on the neighborhood. He stated further that the area already has an influx of undesirables. There was discussion on whether there is an actual need for more multiple family dwellings and if the choice is between multiple family dwellings and trailer cities.

City Recorder, Dorothy Jeffery reported to the Council that Mr. Orville Jeffery had called and stated his approval of the zone change. He said he was unable to attend the meeting as he was just released from the hospital. There being no further public comment, the Mayor closed the hearing at 7:52.
