Mayor Nielson being present called the meeting to order at 7:02 p.m. and stated that time, place and purpose of this meeting had been duly advertised in the Millard County Chronicle; and notice given to the Millard County Gazette; the local radio station, KNAK, and to each member of the governing body.

The Mayor stated the Public Hearing was for the purpose of receiving public comments regarding the Federal Revenue Sharing.

City Administrator Bishop stated that the monies from Federal Revenue Sharing could be used as the City sees fit, with the exception of debt retirement. He recommended that this fund be used for capital items only. If Revenue Sharing were to be discontinued and the City was reliant on it, it could put the City in a bad situation, he said.

City Administrator Bishop presented the proposed expenditures for the Revenue Sharing. He stated that Neil Forster recommended purchase of a truck the same size that the City now has. Mr. Bishop stated that when the budget is adopted that the Revenue Sharing is also adopted.

Mr. Bishop said Congress has been reluctant to do away with the Revenue Sharing Program. It was set up as a means to grant money without all of the red tape.

Mayor Nielson asked if there were any difference of opinion as to where this money should be spent.

The Mayor then adjourned the meeting at 7:18 p.m.
