Mayor Nielson being present called the meeting to order at 7:51 p.m. and stated that the time, place and purpose of the meeting had been duly advertised in the Millard County Chronicle, the Millard County Gazette, the local radio station, KNAK, and notice personally delivered to each member of the governing body two (2) days prior to the meeting and that notice had been posted at the City offices.

Mayor Nielson read the Public Notice: A public hearing has been scheduled for October 3, 1983 at 7:45 p.m. in the City Offices at 309 West Main. The hearing has been scheduled to receive public comments on amendment to Zoning Ordinance (81-26) to allow for private riding and boarding stables for horses in the Highway Commercial (H.C.) Zone. He stated that the notice had been published on September 15, 22, and 29.

Pat Thomas asked why the proposed ordinance included private riding.

Mayor Nielson stated that this was included so both riding and boarding would be allowed. He stated that this was one thing missed in our zoning ordinance, but the City is growing and this zone is needed.

Mrs. Thomas stated that they are building three-sided stables for easy cleaning and putting automatic watering troughs in each stall. She stated that Ron Thomas has kept the area sprayed and has hauled in sandy soil.

Councilman Morrison asked if she had received any opposition from her neighbors.

Mrs. Thomas stated that she had not received any opposition from her neighbors. She asked if there were any questions she could answer.

Mayor Nielson asked if there were any further comments. There were no further comments, so Mayor Nielson then adjourned the meeting at 7:59 p.m.
