Mayor Nielson, being present, called the meeting to order at 6:45 p.m. and stated that the time, place and purpose of the meeting had been duly advertised in the Millard County Chronicle, the Millard County Gazette, and the local radio station, KNAK, and notice was given to each member of the governing body. Mayor Nielson then read the following Public Notice that had been published in the Millard County Chronicle on August 30, September 6, 13, and 20, 1984:

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING AND INTENTION TO VACATE STREET

NOTICE is hereby given pursuant to Sections 10-8-8.3 and 8.4, Utah Code Annotated (1953), as amended, that the Delta City Council intends to declare vacated portions of 350 West Street lying within Block 98 of Plat "A", Delta Townsite. The portion of the street to be vacated is described more particularly as follows:

Beginning at the Northwest corner of Lot 4, Block 98, Plat "A", Delta Townsite; thence South along the West boundary of said Lot 4 to the West right-of-way boundary of Union Pacific Railroad; thence Southeasterly along said right-of-way to the East boundary of Lot 3 of said Block 98; thence North along said East boundary to the Northeast corner of said Lot 3; thence East to the point of beginning.

The City Council will conduct a public hearing on September 24, 1984, at 6:45 p.m. in the Council Chambers of the Delta Municipal Building located at 76 North 200 West in Delta, Utah. The purpose of the hearing will be

to receive public comment and testimony regarding the intended street vacation described above. Persons desiring to make comment or to give testimony at the public hearing should be in attendance at that time.
