Mayor Hansen called the meeting to order at 6:45 p.m. Dorothy Jeffery, City Recorder, acted as secretary. Mayor Hansen stated that notice of the meeting time, place and agenda was posted at the principal office of the governing body located at 76 North 200 West and was provided to the Millard County Chronicle/Progress, the local radio station, KNAK, and to each member of the City Council by personal delivery. Mayor Hansen then read the following notice that had been published in the Millard County Chronicle/Progress on January 8, 1987:

NOTICE, is hereby given that the City Council of the City of Delta has scheduled a Public Hearing for the purpose of receiving public comment regarding the use of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) money for proposed projects within Delta City, Monday, January 12, 1987, at the City Building, located at 76 North 200 West, Delta, Utah, which meeting shall begin promptly at 6:45 p.m.

Mayor Hansen then asked for comments and/or suggestions for proposed projects within Delta City.

Mr. Chad Spor asked if Delta City has received CDBG money before and what it was used for. City Manager Jim Allan indicated that Delta City received CDBG money to upgrade the Delta City Fire Department. Mr. Allan explained that CDBG money could be used for water/sewer projects, economic development, etc.

Mr. Allan said that last year Millard County received the most CDBG money of Millard County applicants, and that Millard County used the money for economic development through a revolving loan fund.

Mr. Clinton Tolbert expressed his opposition to the grant because of the additional expense that it would be to the taxpayers. City Council members explained to Mr. Tolbert that receiving the grant would not impose an additional burden on the City taxpayers.

Clinton Tolbert asked when the CDBG money would have to be paid back. Mayor Hansen explained that the CDBG money is a grant from the Federal Government distributed through a Six County agency and does not have to be paid back. She further explained that the money does have to be used within 18 months for its intended use or it reverts back to the Six County agency.

Mayor Hansen asked for further suggestions for proposed projects.

Rob Hender, KNAK Radio Station, suggested that the money be used by the Chamber of Commerce or to upgrade the old football field.

Council Member Don Dafoe said that the Council is in favor of using CDBG money to establish a revolving loan fund to help stimulate Delta City's business economy by allowing Delta City businesses to borrow money at a low interest rate to purchase capital equipment, etc.

Mayor Hansen asked if there were any further comments or questions regarding the use of CDBG monies. There being none, Mayor Hansen declared the meeting adjourned at 6:55 p.m.
