Mayor Hansen called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. Dorothy Jeffery, City Recorder, acted as secretary. Mayor Hansen stated that notice of the meeting time, place and agenda was posted at the principal office of the governing body located at 76 North 200 West and was provided to the Millard County Chronicle/Progress, the local radio station, KNAK, and to each member of the City Council by personal delivery two days prior to the meeting.

Mayor Hansen stated that the purpose of the Public Hearing was to receive public comment regarding a specific Policy Declaration for the proposed West Delta Annexation. Mayor Hansen asked for comments.

Council Member Don Dafoe spoke in favor of the proposed annexation and said that the annexation area could create a Light Industrial Zone for Delta City.

Council Member Wesley Bloomfield suggested that a letter be written to the property owners in the proposed annexation area encouraging participation in the annexation and listing the advantages of annexing into Delta City. He also recommended that the letter explain that the City is desirous of continuing water service to that area; but, due to certain restrictions, the City is limited in the ways money can be spent outside the City Limits.

Public Works Director Neil Forster explained a plan for upgrading and installation of a water system in the proposed annexation area.

The Council recommended that Mayor Hansen write a letter to the Division of Water Resources informing them of Delta City's intent to proceed with a water project in the proposed annexed area, which would require the remaining balance of \$99,490.97 in Delta City's Escrow Account.

Mayor Hansen declared the meeting adjourned at 7:00 p.m.
