Mayor Dafoe called the meeting to order at 6:45 p.m. Karen Johnson, City Secretary, acted as secretary. Mayor Dafoe stated that notice of the meeting time, place and agenda was posted at the principal office of the governing body located at 76 North 200 West and was provided to the Millard County Chronicle/Progress, the local radio stations, and to each member of the City Council by personal delivery two days prior to the meeting.

Mayor Dafoe explained that the purpose of the Public Hearing was to receive public comment regarding a proposed change in the Delta City Zoning Ordinance. The proposed change would change, from a conditional use to a permitted use, the keeping of animals or fowl for personal use or family food production, not for commercial use, in the Rural Residential zone. The Planning & Zoning Commission has recommended approval of this change in the Zoning Ordinance. The change would allow the keeping of animals or fowl for personal use or family food production, subject to the qualifying regulations and special conditions set forth in the ordinance.

Louise Lyman asked if this change would apply to pets. Mayor Dafoe stated that it applies only to farm animals such as horses, cows, sheep and fowl. Ruth Hansen asked if it had any affect on

those areas where the keeping of horses are "grandfathered". Mayor Dafoe stated that it does not affect those areas.

Mayor Dafoe asked if there were any other questions or comments regarding the proposed change to the zoning ordinance. There was no opposition to the change.
