Mayor Bunker called the public hearing to order at 6:35 p.m. He stated that notice of the meeting time, place and agenda had been posted at the City Building and had been provided to the Millard County Chronicle/Progress and to each member of the City Council at least two days prior to the meeting. City Recorder Gregory Schafer acted as secretary.

Mayor Bunker stated that the purpose of the public hearing was to receive public comment regarding the proposed Delta City Water Conservation Plan. He then opened the public hearing to comment from the floor.

Mr. Mark Lovell asked why Delta City feels that a water conservation plan is important at this time. Mayor Bunker answered that the water table is dropping and it is a matter of time until problems are encountered. Mr. Lovell expressed concern that the water conservation plan was a new rate or tax increase rather than a necessary program to encourage water conservation. Council Member Margaret Dutson mentioned that the State of Utah requires a water conservation plan in order to receive any funding for water projects and Delta City will be requesting funding in order to comply with new arsenic standards for drinking water, which go into effect in 2006. Mayor Bunker stated that Delta City has taken a very minimal approach to water conservation compared to the measures other cities are taking.


Mayor Bunker thanked Mr. Lovell for his remarks. No other comments were received from the floor.
