
Mayor Bunker called the public hearing to order at 6:45 p.m. He stated that notice of the time, place and agenda of the public hearing had been posted at the City Building and had been provided to the Millard County Chronicle/Progress and to each member of the City Council at least two days prior to the meeting.

Mayor Bunker explained that the purpose of the public hearing was to receive public comment regarding proposed amendments to the Delta City Budget for Fiscal Year 2006-2007. The proposed amendments were discussed at the previous meeting and Council Members had copies of the proposed amendments. Mayor Bunker noted that the purpose of the amendments was to provide \$50,000 for construction of a jet fuel facility at the municipal airport, an amount which will be matched by Intermountain Power Agency, and \$25,000 for the centennial celebration activities. Council Members discussed the proposed amendments. City Librarian Deb Greathouse expressed concern regarding the amount being taken from the Library budget for books inasmuch as she has committed to a Smithsonian Institute display for this year and book purchases which have already been ordered.

Mayor Bunker opened the public hearing to comment from the floor. The only comment was that previously issued by City Librarian Deb Greathouse.

Mayor Bunker declared the public hearing adjourned at 6:55 p.m.
