VAL KOFED, SUNRISE ENGINEERING, INC.: DOWNTOWN BEAUTIFICATION PROJECT - CDBG

Mayor Dafoe introduced Val Kofed, Sunrise Engineering, Inc., and asked him to present a proposed Downtown Beautification Project.

Val Kofed, Sunrise Engineering, Inc., introduced himself and the staff at Sunrise Engineering after which he explained that Delta City obtained a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) to be used for planning and designing a Downtown Beautification Project. He said that most of the survey work necessary has been completed and plans have been discussed for water, sewer, and storm drain line improvements.


Mr. Kofed then introduced Mr. James Bach, Landscape Architect, and asked him to present plans for above ground improvements.

Mr. Bach presented several conceptual drawings of improvements for downtown Delta from 500 West to Center Street. Those improvements include extended sidewalks with planters, trees, benches, water fountains, etc. Also presented was a plan for a raised median in the middle of Main Street with trees planted along it. Discussion was held regarding the pros and cons of the median. A vote was taken to see how many were in favor of the median. The majority of those in attendance voted in favor of the raised median.

General discussion was held regarding the proposed plan after which Mayor Dafoe declared the meeting adjourned at 8:15 p.m.
