

Delta City Library Board Meeting Minutes

November 5, 2008

Delta City Library Board Meeting began at 8:00 p.m. with Becky Prestwich, Bret Draper, Monica Schafer, Kiley Chase, Deb Greathouse and Marsha Lovell were in attendance. Matt Williams and Sandra Topham were not in attendance. President Bret Draper conducted the meeting.

The minutes from February and June's meetings were read and a motion was made to approve it. They were approved with a few minor changes.

The authors from the Utah Humanities Book Festival were evaluated. It was very well attended and was interesting. The authors were Kathrine Coles and Ann Cannon.

On January 8, 2009 a former skinhead, T.J. Leyden will be coming to speak. We need to help tell the community about it. We also need to send out flyers.

Ideas for display cases are needed and some ideas were discussed. Brad Williams has 20,000 hot wheels, Becky Prestwich has Star Wars cards and a National display could be put together with things missionaries have collected.

A discussion was held about why we need a library card to let the kids use the internet. A motion was made to change the policy that they have to have a library card to use the internet and it was approved.

Circulation is down by 3,000 books in the children's materials.

An annual statistical report of public library services fiscal year 2008 was handed out.

There was a discussion about password protecting the wireless connection in the library.

Mary Lyman Henrie's family donated three books to the library.

Starting in January we have a grant for \$4,900 to buy books for teenagers for a year. A book group for teens was discussed.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:05 p.m. The next meeting will be held on January 21, 2009.
