

Delta City Library Board Meeting

January 21, 2009

Delta City Library Board Meeting began at 8:00 p.m. with Marsha Lovell, Deb Greathouse, Bret Draper, Kiley Chase, Sandra Topham, Monica Schaffer, and Becky Prestwich in attendance. Matt Williams was not in attendance. President Bret Draper conducted the meeting.

The minutes from the November 5, 2009 meeting were read and were approved with some minor changes.

TJ Leyden's assembly about being a skinhead was evaluated. Most people did not like the assembly. There was too much swearing and they felt like he did not get the point across that he felt bad about what he did.

There was a discussion about Stephen Trimble's presentation and everyone that attended thought it was very good and well attended.

The librarians are clamping down on internet usage. They need a parent to sign that they can use the internet. A discussion was held about how we can make it easier to find the information, that a parent has signed a note for kids to use the internet, rather than looking it up every time. The idea was brought up that fingerprint recognition is available to identify people who are using the computer.

Teen book group is held every third Thursday at 3:30 p.m. and the first meeting was last Thursday. They talked about the book "Swindle" by Gordon Gorman. There are about 20 books available for every month for the teens to choose from. They are trying to get books that are not used at school.

Overdrive/NetLibrary <http://pioneer.utah.gov> is now compatible to download books and movies (mostly educational movies) on ipods also, not just on mp3 players, for a certain time period.

A Night of 1,000 Stars will be held on April 15, 2009. A discussion was held about doing the same thing or trying something different. It was decided that we would have "Maxed Out Puppetry" come and perform. It will cost about \$150 for 45 minutes. This year we will not give books away. It will be held at the Delta South Elementary. We will need to make posters, flyers and tell the kids at the schools. We need to make sure the kids at the North Elementary know it is for them also.

Story Hour has not been very well attended lately. It was decided that advertising may help. Maybe it could be put in the school newsletters or on the City Water Bills.

There was a discussion on the new Museum and Civic Center. A building design is being decided on. The Great Basin Museum, Topaz and Daughters of the Utah Pioneers will all be a part of it.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:05 p.m and the next meeting will be held on Thursday, March 26, 2009.
