

## Delta City Library Board Meeting

January 27, 2010 – 8:00 p.m.

Meeting was called to order by President Sandra Topham at 8:05 p.m.

Those in attendance were Robert Banks, Becky Prestwich, Deb Greathouse, Sandra Topham and Marsha Lovell. Those not in attendance were Tammie Bean, John DeGrey, Monica Schafer.

The minutes were read and approved.

The Book Festival was evaluated. Terrell Dougan did a great job. Her book, That Went Well, was about her sister that was mentally ill. Obert Skye also did very well. He is the author of the “Leven Thumps” series. It was very well attended and entertaining.

Utah State Library is requiring us to purchase new software if we want to stay with the Bookmobile. That will mean changing all the barcodes to 14 digits and will cost about \$3,000 per year if we stay with Bookmobile. Deb is still looking at other options trying to make it all work without the expense and down time to change the barcodes.

Replacing the glass doors in the library was not approved. There is a possibility of getting a grant for a handicapped door.

The teen book group is going alright. There are only enough books to last until July. Sandra Topham will be in charge of the book discussion February 18<sup>th</sup>. The book is The Last Knight by Hilari Bell. The adult book group is going great.

Overdrive/NetLibrary is going good.

Night of 1,000 Stars will be held on Wednesday, April 14, 2010 at 7:00 p.m. It will be changed to the Delta Elementary if possible. Possible readers were discussed and a list made. It was decided to give out books and prizes that were left over from other years. Advertising was discussed and it was decided that Becky would make posters and put an ad on the car wash sign. Deb will contact the schools and also see if it can be put on the city water bills.

The updates for the digitization grant needs to be done by February 28, 2010.

The city needs to make budget cuts that may affect the library.

The next board meeting will be held on March 24, 2010 at 8:00 p.m.
