RESOLUTION 84-106

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF INTERIM WARRANT NUMBER 1, FOR THE PURPOSE OF INTERIM FINANCING THE CONSTRUCTION OF IMPROVEMENTS AND SERVICES PERFORMED IN CONNECTION WITH DELTA CITY, UTAH SPECIAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 83-1.

WHEREAS, John Quick, City Engineer, has presented to the City Council his partial estimate report indicating that the value of work performed and completed by Sky Line Construction in connection with its construction contract with Delta City regarding said Special Improvement District No. 83-1 totals \$42,676.98; and

WHEREAS, John Quick, City Engineer, has submitted his certificate that the amount specified in Interim Warrant

No. 1 herein is not in excess of 90% of the value of the work completed as determined by the City Engineer;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of Delta City, Millard County, Utah:

Section 1. That the partial estimate of the value of work completed in the Delta City, Utah Special Improvement District No. 83-1 as submitted by John Quick, City Engineer, be accepted and approved, and the Mayor and City Council are hereby authorized to issue Interim Warrant No. 1 in the amount of \$ 38,409.29.

Section 2. That the City Council does hereby express its intent to issue special assessment bonds on or before completion of the improvements of Delta City, Utah Special Improvement District No. 83-1, for purposes of retiring all interim warrants of said special improvement district and financing completion of said improvements in a proper and workmanlike manner.
