

RESOLUTION NO. 84-109

A RESOLUTION INCREASING KENNEL FEES AND IMPOUNDING FEES FOR DOGS IMPOUNDED UNDER CHAPTER 13-200 ENTITLED "ANIMAL CONTROL" OF THE REVISED ORDINANCES OF DELTA CITY (1981 edition).

RECITALS

The City Council of the City of Delta, Utah (referred to herein as the "City Council") hereby recites the following as the basis for adopting this resolution:

A. Delta City has previously contracted for Dennis Westwood to provide the animal control and kennel services as set out in Chapter 13-200 of the Revised Ordinances of Delta City (1981 edition) based on charges for such services set out therein.

B. Since adoption of the fees set out in Chapter 13-200, costs of impounding and caring for animals have increased due to inflation and construction of animal shelters meeting applicable standards. The City Council therefore has determined that the impounding fees and kennel fees should be increased by resolution under the authority set out in Section 13-254 of the Revised Ordinances.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Delta, Utah:

Section 1. Impounding Fees Increased. The impounding fee to be paid for redemption of impounded dogs as established under Section 13-254 is hereby set at \$10.00 per dog in lieu of the \$5.00 fee set out in Section 13-254.

Section 2. Kennel Fees. The kennel fees established by Section 13-254 at \$.50 per animal per day are hereby increased to \$2.00 per animal per day.

Section 3. Payment Prior to Redemption. All fees set by this resolution shall be paid prior to redemption of animals from the City pound.

Section 4. Effective Date. This resolution shall become effective upon adoption.

Section 5. Severability. In the event that any provision of this resolution less than the entire resolution is held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, this resolution shall be deemed severable and such finding of invalidity shall not affect the remaining portions of this resolution.

Section 6. Repeal of Conflicting Resolutions. To the extent that any resolutions or policies of the City of Delta conflict with the provisions of this resolution, they are hereby amended to be in accordance with the provisions hereof.
