

RESOLUTION 85-140

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DELTA, UTAH IDENTIFYING CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE CITY OF DELTA AND ESTABLISHING A PRIORITY THEREFOR.

RECITALS

The City Council of the City of Delta, Utah, referred to herein as the "City Council," hereby recites the following as the basis for adopting this resolution:

A. Delta City has limited capital budget resources from which to acquire funds for construction of new capital facilities needed for the residents of the City of Delta.

B. The City Council finds that the City of Delta, in order to meet the needs of its residents, must plan for improvements to existing capital facilities, construction of new capital facilities and replacement of facilities which have become obsolete or which become unusable.

C. The City Council further finds that it is necessary to identify, establish priorities for and plan for the construction of such capital facilities and therefore wishes to adopt this resolution identifying certain capital improvement projects for the period beginning in 1985 and ending in 1990 and establishing priorities for said projects.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Delta, Utah:

1. Capital Improvements Project Identification and Priority List Adopted. The City Council hereby adopts the list attached hereto as Exhibit "A" entitled "1985-1990 Capital Improvements Projects" as the capital improvements projects plan for that period for the City of Delta, Utah.

2. Priorities Established. The City Council hereby adopts the priorities set in the attached Exhibit "A" and hereby directs that the Mayor and such other City personnel as he may direct; including, among others, the City Manager, undertake to obtain funding for said projects and that any funds obtained be applied to the projects described in Exhibit "A" in the priority identified therein.

3. Effective Date. This resolution shall become effective upon adoption.

4. Severability. In the event that any provision of this resolution less than the entire resolution is held invalid

by a court of competent jurisdiction, this resolution shall be deemed severable and such finding of invalidity shall not affect the remaining portions of this resolution.

5. Repeal of Conflicting Resolutions. To the extent that any resolutions or policies of the City of Delta conflict with the provisions of this resolution, they are hereby amended to be in accordance with the provisions hereof.
