

RESOLUTION NO. 87-163

A RESOLUTION OF THE DELTA CITY COUNCIL ESTABLISHING A SEWER CAPITAL RESERVE FUND FOR THE PURPOSE OF INSTALLING SEWERS, SEWER LINES, LINE EXTENSIONS, UPGRADING EXISTING LIFT STATIONS, REPLACEMENT OF EXISTING LIFT STATIONS AND PROVIDING FOR SEWER EXPANSION FOR ANNEXED AREAS.

WHEREAS, the Delta City Council has determined that there is a need to establish a Sewer Capital Reserve Fund for the purpose of funding sewer expansion to annexed areas, installation of sewers, sewer lines, line extensions, upgrading or replacing lift stations and purchasing equipment associated with carrying out said activities of the Sewer Department and to otherwise make the necessary expenditures to carry out the activities of the Sewer Department; and

WHEREAS, on April 27, 1987, the Delta City Council, at a regularly held City Council meeting, moved to establish a Sewer Capital Reserve Fund for the purposes expressed in the next preceding paragraph; and

WHEREAS, this resolution ratifies the action taken by the Delta City Council on April 27, 1987, establishing said Sewer Capital Reserve Fund,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Delta, Utah:

Section 1. Sewer Capital Reserve Fund. Pursuant to motion made at the April 27, 1987 Delta City Council meeting, there is created a Sewer Capital Reserve Fund which shall include, but not be limited to, providing funds for purposes of sewer expansion to annexed areas, installation of sewers, sewer lines, line extensions, upgrading or replacing lift stations and purchasing equipment associated with carrying out said activities of the Sewer Department and to otherwise make necessary expenditures to carry out the activities of said Sewer Department.


Section 2. Ratification. The Delta City Council has heretofore recognized that said Sewer Capital Reserve Fund has been in existence prior to June 15, 1987, and by this resolution hereby ratifies any action previously taken to establish said fund and to transfer any funds thereto and transact any business associated therewith.

Section 3. Effective Date. This resolution shall be effective upon adoption and shall remain in effect for a period of five years from the date of adoption.

Section 4. Severability. In the event that any provision of this resolution less than the entire resolution is held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, this resolution shall be deemed severable and such finding of invalidity shall not affect the remaining portions of this resolution.

Section 5. Repeal of Conflicting Resolutions. To the extent that any resolutions or policies of the City of Delta conflict with the provisions of this resolution, they are hereby amended to be in accordance with the provisions hereof.
