- 19 Mayor Bunker called the public hearing to order at 6:30 p.m. He stated that notice of the time, place, and
- 20 the agenda of the meeting had been posted at the City Building, on the City website, on the Utah Public
- 21 Notice website and had been provided to the Millard County Chronicle-Progress and to each member of
- 22 the City Council at least two days prior to the meeting.
- 23 Mayor Bunker stated that the purpose of holding this public hearing was to discuss making application to
- 24 the Permanent Community Impact Fund Board (PCIFB) for the City's proposed wastewater project. Mayor
- 25 Bunker added that the topics to be discussed were the funding options, project scope, implementation,
- 26 schedule, and the effects on residents. Public Works Director Kirkland explained some of the sewer line
- 27 problems that he would like to have fixed. Public Works Director Kirkland explained why he would prefer
- 28 to line the problematic pipes rather than replace them. Further, Public Works Director Kirkland informed
- 29 the Council that lining the sewer lines would cost approximately \$45,000 to \$60,000 and the PCIFB would
- 30 likely treat it as 50% grant and 50% loan or match. Public Works Director Kirkland stated that a sewer 31
- master plan would cost roughly the same. Public Works Director Kirkland explained what the sewer
- 32 master plan entailed. Council Member Niles asked if the City would be able to match the costs and
- 33 Recorder Schafer confirmed that there was money in the City's Sewer Capital Reserve that could be used
- 34 toward it.
