-URGENT NOTICE-MILLARD COUNTY TRANSFER STATION

Due to ongoing issues and prior warnings not being effective, Millard County will begin actively citing people who do not follow the transfer station rules.

As a reminder, anything that does not fit in the bins should be taken directly to the landfill. We have been informed that they will not charge for household garbage that does not fit in the bins. Construction material and unbagged yard waste should always be taken directly to the landfill.

GENERAL GARBAGE REMINDERS

As weather warms up, so have neighbor complaints about weeds and garbage not being properly contained, being smelly and/or attracting cats, mice, and other critters. To help keep your neighbors happy, please take care of your weeds and do not store garbage in your yard or in open vehicles. See code online for details.

Also, park dumpsters are for park use ONLY. We love when you clean up. after your park outings, but please don't use them to clean out your house. Personal dumping is not allowed. You can haul it directly to the transfer station or contact a local hauling service.
