LAWN MOWING SEASON

Please use caution mowing around your water meter. Repairs to technical equipment on the lid can be costly and are charged to the utility account.

RULES FOR BURNING

- Contact Sheriff's Office at 435-864-2755.
 - No burning household trash, garbage, plastics, coated wires, oils, hazardous materials & other such materials.
 - No burning in areas that would threaten shrubs or dry grasses.
 - No burning during periods of high wind, posted fire restriction periods, during red flag warnings, etc.
 - No burning within 50' of buildings and structures.
 - Burn only materials that are dry and reasonably free of dirt.
 - Have adequate water supply on site or other means to extinguish or contain fire from spreading.
 - Create adequate fuel break at 2.5 times the height of the fire.
 - Notify your neighbors.
 - A competent person must attend the fire at all times and all fires must be completely extinguished before dark or leaving the area.
- YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANYTHING YOUR FIRE OR ITS SMOKE DOES.**

MISCELLANEOUS SPRING REMINDERS

- Now is the time to spray weeds.
- Building permits are required for most projects, please check with the City Office to see if you need one.
- Call 811 before you dig.
- Please be mindful of your dogs barking, even during the day. (Some of our beloved senior citizens asked us to let you know that their well-earned naps are being interrupted)

SPRING CLEAN UP

Spring clean-up is scheduled for May 3-4, 2024 and will be for GREEN WASTE ONLY. For pick up you MUST:
-Call the City Office at 435-864-2759 and be placed on the list.
-Place items in the right of way. We cannot take green waste piles that have anything else mixed in with them.

Please do your best to haul any items you can and help your neighbors. Don't forget to cover your loads on the way to the landfill.
